 - (2) Applicant school is advised to identify a suitable location for the food waste composter with nearby electricity supply. The location should be covered, well ventilated and free of disturbance to the teachers and students in the proposed installation area.
 - (3) Successful applicant schools will be required:
 - a. to carry out educational activities and operate the composter for cultivating teachers' and students' "Food Wise" culture, reducing food waste and demonstrating the recycling of food waste into compost for use in planting on campus for three consecutive academic years; and
 - b. to provide food waste composter operational record and other relevant information.

Personal Data Collection Statement

Purpose of Collection

The personal data and other related information provided in the Application Form will be used by the Environment and Conservation Fund (ECF) Committee/Environmental Campaign Committee (ECC) and their sub-committees and the ECF/ECC Secretariat (the Secretariat) for the purpose of processing the application.
